How to Use Zoom from Moodle for Students

Log in your student portal at https://my.nwc.edu/. On the right side of your portal you will see the moodle icon. You may click on it, or on one of the classes below it.




Depending on the way your instructor's moodle page is setup, you may see the links in different ways. These are some of the ways an instructor may post the zoom links:





or you may see it this way, as an assignment in Moodle:

• click on "Zoom meeting," and then on "Join Meeting."




Once you click on the appropriate link your browser will take you automatically to zoom.






You may see a popup with a preview of your camera. You can decide if you want your video on or off before you join the meeting. You can also select "join without video," and you may turn the camera on once you connect to the meeting.

If you see a "Join Audio" icon at the bottom-left of your screen you microphone and speakers are not connected. Click on it and select "Join With Computer Audio." You can also test your speakers and microphone by clicking below the blue button.





If you are having problems with your audio, either speakers or microphone, click on the carat ^ next to the microphone icon. From that menu you can select your microphone and speakers. You can also test your audio (mic and speakers). Click on "Test Speakers and Microphone and follow the prompts.





To the right of the video icon there's a carat ^ that when selected will display the video selection menu. This is useful in case you have multiple cameras (i.e. a webcam and a laptop camera), and you want to switch between them.
