**Plan overview:** Enrollment management is a process that enables Northwest College to identify enrollment goals that connect with its mission, strategic plan, and resources. The Enrollment Management Plan is a dynamic and holistic plan consisting of two parts: the Recruitment Plan and the Retention Plan. The Enrollment Advisory Committee, which oversees the development, implementation and assessment of the plan, is made up of cross-functional members to assist in integration of administrative processes, student services, curriculum, and marketing. Faculty, academic support personnel, student affairs staff, college relations staff, administrative services staff, the institutional researcher, and one student are members of the committee. The full committee meets monthly to monitor the progress of the sub-committee's work. All units coordinate to provide the best service to students.
