



**HATHAWAY SCHOLARSHIP APPEAL PETITION  
STANDARDS OF SATISFACTORY ACADEMIC PROGRESS**

Hathaway Scholarship Rules and Regulations require Northwest College to review Standards of Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) at the end of each spring semester for all Hathaway Scholarship recipients. Hathaway recipients are required to complete at least 6 credit hours if considered part-time for Hathaway payment or 12 hours if considered full-time. The minimum Hathaway GPA requirement is 2.25. Recipients are also required to maintain continuous enrollment.

Students who fail to meet the standards, because of extenuating circumstances, may appeal their scholarship eligibility. Circumstances must be of good cause and outside of the student’s control. Examples of extenuating circumstances could be the death of a close relative to the student, or a significant injury or illness of the student or family member.

To appeal scholarship eligibility, the student must complete this Hathaway Scholarship Standards of Satisfactory Academic Progress Appeal Petition. *Complete and return this form with appropriate documentation such as copies of medical bills, or statement from physicians, psychologists, or other professionals or death certificate to the Financial Aid Office.* Your petition will be reviewed to determine if Hathaway Scholarship funding will be reinstated. Appeals which are denied can be appealed to the Wyoming Department of Education.
