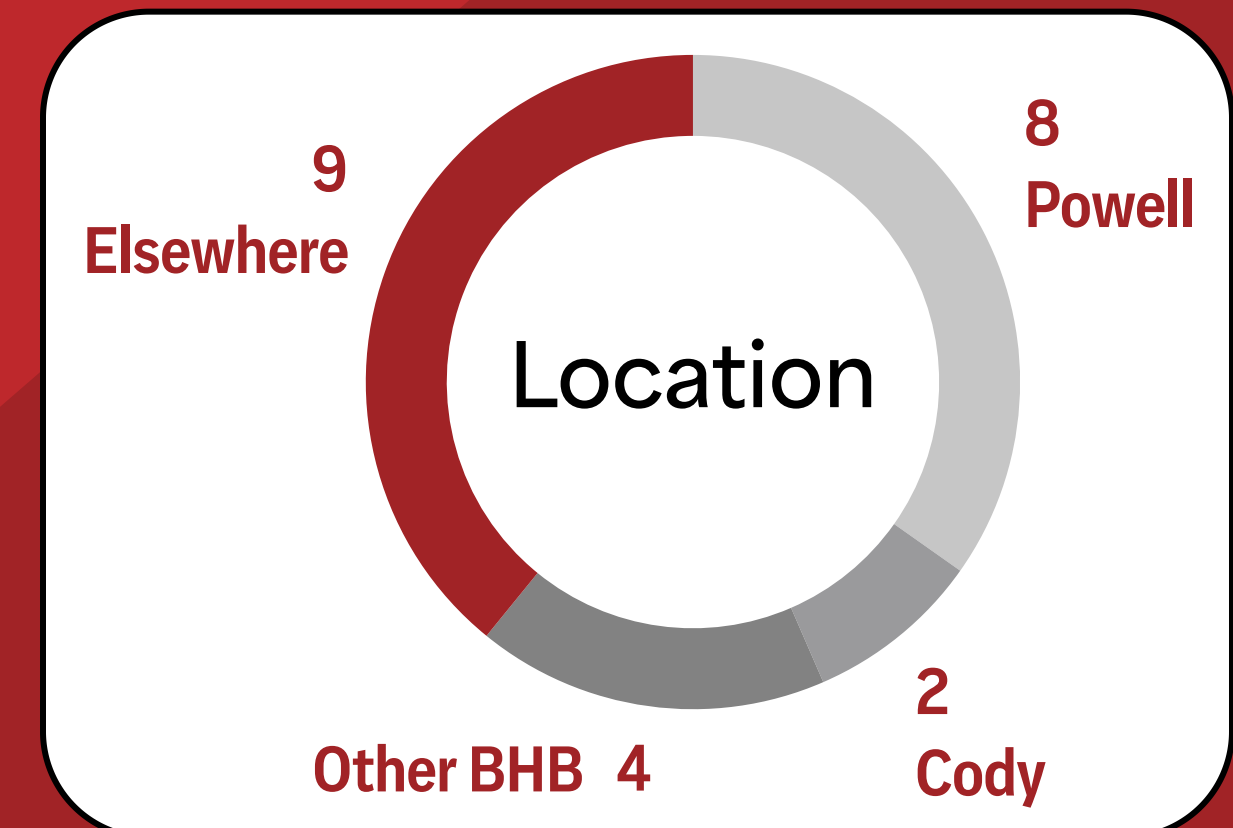
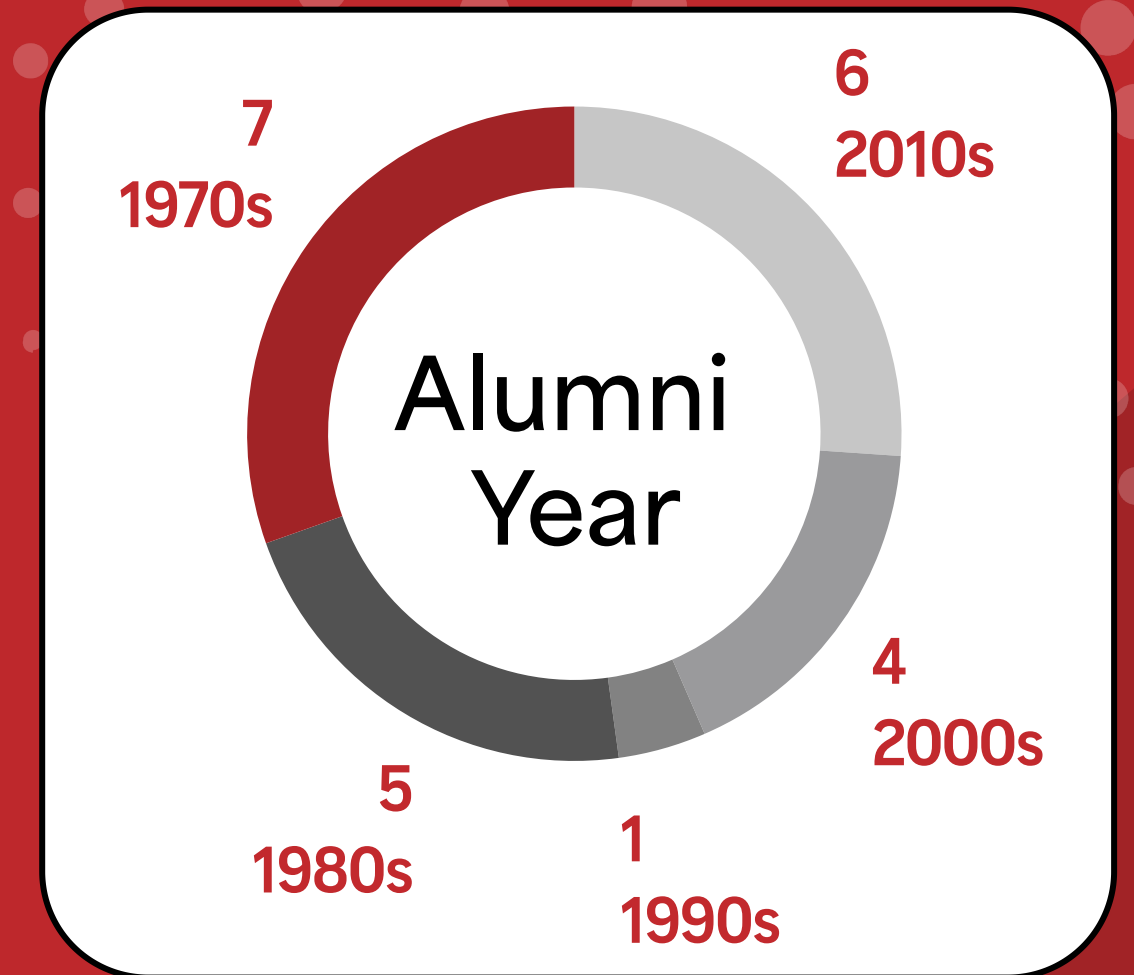

 - No limit on number of terms

 - 4 new members began in July.
