"We all need to give back. It makes us better people." – Dr. Tom Anderson

"After Dolores died in 2004, Bob came to see me. He wanted to donate money in her honor to make a difference for people in his community. He was thinking about donating to our cancer center," said Dr. Tom Anderson, now a retired oncologist from Cody, Wyo.

In a small-town rural setting and a profession with a highburnout rate, Dr. Anderson noted educating nurses at Northwest College would provide the best support of all.

"Right away, Tom recommended the Northwest College nurses' program. He told me the nursing program could use the money and we could use the nurses," shared Cody businessman Bob Snyder. "The great thing about it was the money was matched."

At that time, the State of Wyoming was helping community colleges build their endowments by matching endowed donations dollar for dollar. Snyder was excited that his donation to begin a nursing scholarship in Dolores' name was doubled with the matching funds.

Having spawned the idea for the Dolores Snyder Nursing Scholarship, Dr. Anderson realized the gift had made an impact on him, too.



"After attending a Winifred S. Wasden Reading at NWC to hear from novelist Richard Ford, I realized that I could make a contribution in her name since she had been one of my patients. Over time, I grew to believe that honoring other former patients was a noble endeavor." Since his first gift to the Foundation in 2006, Dr. Anderson has given in honor of cancer victims who were former patients, including Carrie Gasch, Dick Wilder, and, of course, Dolores Snyder, plus others.

It's only natural that Dr. Anderson's tradition of giving developed as an extension of his professional practice.

"In my day, most doctors were motivated by the concept of serving society," he shared. "We were so driven. I was on call every other night for much of my early career; we believed that if we wanted to be good doctors we needed these extra hours to gain experience. Unfortunately that meant we weren't good family role models."

Dr. Anderson IS a role model, however, in his devotion to service above self. Though he is no longer a practicing physician, he continues to make a difference in his community. He maintains a list of charitable causes he believes in—among them are Trout



Unlimited (Dr. Anderson is an avid fly fisher), the Nature Conservancy, his alma maters (the University of Montana, Stanford and the University of Rochester), and lucky for our students, Northwest College.

"I know even my small gifts can make a difference when they are combined with the gifts of others, and I believe I need to do my part," said Anderson. Then he shared a story of Michael Bloomberg, American billionaire philanthropist.

"The year after Michael Bloomberg graduated from John's Hopkins University, he donated \$5 to his alma mater. That was all he could afford, but he believed that even small gifts make a difference, and they help to ingrain in us the habit of giving." Anderson noted in 2013, Bloomberg (at the time the mayor of New York City) gave Johns Hopkins \$350 million dollars, elevating his total contributions to the school to more than \$1 billion and making him the most generous living donor to any educational institution in the U.S.

Like Dr. Anderson and his wife, Rita, Bob and Dolores Snyder have been long-standing community beneficiaries. Along with the nursing scholarship that bears her name, Dolores' legacy encompasses her time as a member of the Cody Music Club, the choir director at the Episcopal Church, and a woman who threw her energy and sense of fun into everything she did. Bob has also honored her passion for music with gifts to NWC's civic orchestra and chorale (NCOC).

Dr. Anderson is passionate about his point; we all need to give back. It makes us better people. He also knows making small gifts builds productive lifelong habits. And when merged with other donations, the dollars add up to do special things.

Paying it forward

It's rare that NWC Foundation receives a donation to the annual fund drive from someone in his or her mid-20s, but Tyler Yates, age 27, has been giving back to NWC for 4 years. When Yates's gift arrived during the 2017 annual fundraising campaign, Foundation staff reached out to him to find out what inspires his generosity.

What makes NWC special to you?

Year after year I find myself going back and staying involved with the events put on by NWC and taking the time to maintain the friendships with my many mentors-turned-friends. NWC was the first place I felt

I belonged, a sentiment many of my classmates share as well. As a community college, that sense of belonging extends out into the towns NWC serves providing a great opportunity to meet people and stay involved.

It's very unusual for somebody to begin giving at the age of 23. What prompted you to make your first donation to the NWC Foundation?

As a student I worked the phonathon that the Foundation office does every year, so when I got a call from a student asking if I would make a donation, I realized it was a donation to support students and to provide others with the same opportunities I had received.

My time at NWC was such an important time in my life and it was through the giving of others that I was able to attend with a full scholarship. If those scholarships had not been available, I may not have gone to college. I understand how important my education was and that as an alumnus it's important for me to pass along those same opportunities whenever I can. Working in the Foundation office, I realized how. . . lots of little donations could add up and make a big impact. My first donation was not going to put someone through school, but with the help of others I knew it would make a difference.

Who on campus made a difference in your life and how?

Cynthia Garhart. Keli Borders. Gary Sturmer. Lou McPhail. Val Cross. Burt Bradley. Char Kline. Lydia Hernandez. Rob Stothart. I'm sure there are others as well.

Most importantly was Holly Berryman. Not only was she my boss, but she also became my friend, a teacher and someone I could always talk to. That is one thing that all of these people have in common; the staff at NWC take the time to get to know every student and it is very evident that they care beyond whatever their job title may be. Faculty and staff make NWC what it is, a Community College. The very name of the campus exemplifies why it is such a rewarding place to be—made possible by the great people who work there.

NWC made an impact on Tyler's life, and now he's paying it forward to today's students.

I have come to really appreciate how important and liberating an education can be. . . by giving back I hope to provide someone else with the opportunity to experience what I did while at NWC.
