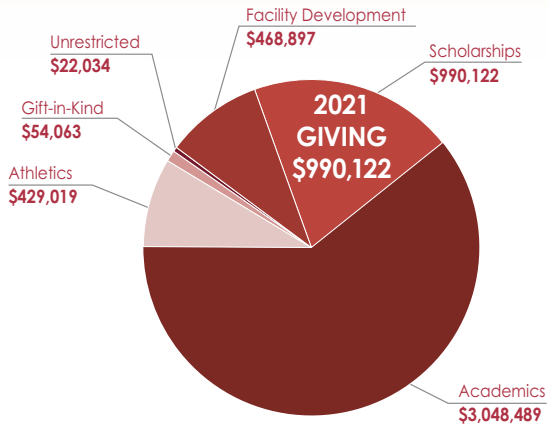

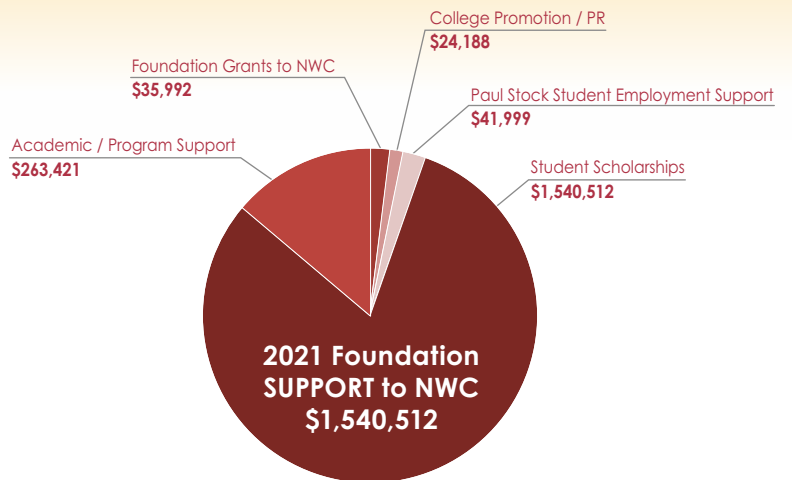

# Education MATTERS...

**If you were to look at the Northwest College Foundation Board of Directors list, you'd find individuals who reside in a variety of different places, including Wyoming, Montana, Utah, and as of 2019, Switzerland.**

When NWC alumnus Ron Weathermon '91 contacted Foundation Executive Director Shelby Wetzel, he asked how he could become more involved in the Foundation's work and if it was possible to do so from Basel, Switzerland.

"Northwest has always been close to my heart," Ron said. "I wanted to be a greater part of the College."

The quarterly board meetings always start at 4 p.m. in person or via Zoom, but for Ron, who is eight time zones ahead of Wyoming, they get underway at midnight and

are often complete around 2 a.m., his time.

Ron's generosity extends beyond his service on the board. What began with a gift to chemistry scholarships in 1995, a few years after he graduated, has since grown into a diverse giving history that has touched many areas of campus and positively impacted many science students' lives.

Three years ago, Ron's mother passed away from cancer, inspiring him to create the Weathermon Health Sciences Scholarship Endowment, which

was established to help support education for full-time students majoring in pre-professional sciences. Throughout the years, he's also shared his generosity with other science-related areas of campus that he's been part of.

Like many others, however, Ron's involvement in NWC began during his time as a student. His siblings and father attended Northwest, and after graduating high school in Laurel, Montana, he felt like coming to Powell for his education would be a natural fit.

He has fond memories of his time



on campus and recalls how the residence halls were constantly buzzing with activity. As a student, Ron studied pre-pharmacy and enjoyed feeling at the center of a community. Under the supervision of Dee Havig, who is currently the interim vice president for student services, he became a resident assistant.

He recalls enjoying learning from faculty and staff members like Neil Hansen, Dave Barkan, and Havig.

“I remember there was this time at the end of the semester where it was -20 below,” he said. “Cars wouldn’t start, and there was nothing to do, so we were all up to no good in the residence halls. Dee caught us,” he laughed.

Soon after his time in Powell, he attended Idaho State University, where he earned his doctorate in pharmacy. “Even after I graduated, at the end of the day, everything always seemed to point back to Northwest College,” he explained.

Ron is currently the project lead and head of global medical affairs and training governance for Novartis International, a global pharmaceutical company based in Switzerland. Novartis employs more than 100,000 people across 120 countries.

He often jokes he originally came to Switzerland on a two-year assignment; he’s now lived there for 12 years. Ron wears a variety of hats in his current position and has had several roles within the company, now spending much of his time working to protect patients’ medical data. Throughout his career, he’s worked in 16 different time zones.

Noting his passion for the outdoors, Ron describes Switzerland as his “fountain of youth” because of the endless opportunities for biking, hiking, and other outdoor activities.

He also enjoys the country’s diversity and various opportunities he has to learn about different cultures. As a world traveler, he’s visited more than 30 countries.

Now, when he looks back, he wishes he would have taken

advantage of the recreation opportunities available in the area when he was a student at NWC. He emphasizes that Northwest is more than an academic experience.

“With Yellowstone National Park about an hour away, there are endless world-class outdoor activities. Now, when I go back to Powell, it’s really about getting back to nature.”

For prospective students who are thinking about attending NWC, Ron offers a piece of advice: “Challenge yourself. Take classes that will set yourself up for the future.”

In his free time, he enjoys hiking, cycling, and yoga. He plans to spend the summer in Croatia with his wife Martina.

# Endowed Chairs



## \$3 million gift to NWC Foundation creates first endowed chair positions at Northwest College

Made possible by a gift from a local alumni couple who chose to refrain from publicity, Northwest College can now create—for the first time in its history—two endowed chair positions for the science and education departments.

The Northwest College Foundation is the beneficiary of just over \$3 million, which is the largest single gift to the Foundation to fund the two chairs.

“We are tremendously grateful for our donors’ generosity and dedication to education at Northwest College,” NWC President Lisa Watson said. “This lasting gift is truly a landmark moment for NWC, one that ensures our ability to support academic opportunities for years to come and reflects the amazing support for our institution.”

Candidates are expected to have a record of outstanding achievement in scholarship, teaching, and service in their field, and have a commitment to students and leadership at NWC.

The purpose of Endowed Chairs is to recruit and retain faculty with outstanding scholarly records who will provide leadership that enriches Northwest College.

It’s both an honor to the appointed chair holder and an enduring tribute to the donor who establishes it.

The gift will create two endowments, each valued at \$1.5 million with investment proceeds supporting the chair position and special programming. The first priority for funding will be salary support for each position. The NWC Foundation will also provide an incentive or reward for the faculty members who are named to each chair.

“We’ve designed a system to allocate a portion of the money for professional development and funds to support innovative curricula development by the respective faculty chairs,” Executive Director of the Northwest College Foundation Shelby Wetzel said. “Our goal is to continue inspiring teaching that provides exceptional learning opportunities for students at Northwest College.”

After graduating from Cody High School, one of the donors attended Northwest College and later earned a professional degree before he returned to work in Park County.

His wife earned her education degree through the University of Wyoming from the NWC campus, completing many of her general education courses at Northwest. She later went on to teach in Park County’s public schools.

Together, the two enjoyed sharing their passion for all Wyoming has to offer with friends and family. Now, they are extending their kindness to share the gift of education at NWC.

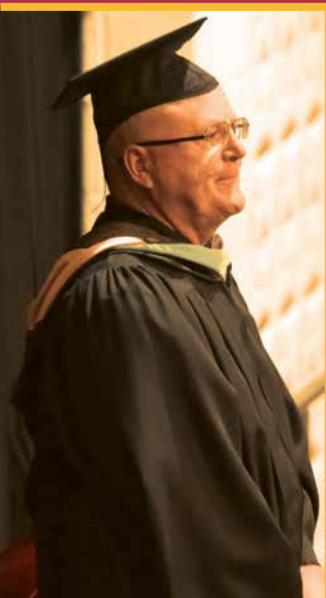

# ALUMNI PROFILE...

## Dee Havig ['79]

For 34 years, Dee Havig has been a fixture on the campus of Northwest College. Havig attended NWC as a student in 1977 before marrying his wife Julie two years later. Before his career in higher education, he lived in North Dakota for a year and was then hired by Amoco Oil and moved back to Powell. In the summer of 1987, there was an opening for a Resident Director position in Ashley Hall, and Havig convinced Julie to let him apply. Though it was a pay decrease from what he was earning at Amoco, the Resident Director position included room, board and insurance and he was offered the job. At this point, Havig started his new life at Northwest College with Julie, son Jake who was in kindergarten and daughter Sarah who was three-years-old.

Over the years, Havig has worn many hats at NWC. He's been a Resident Director at Ashley and Lewis & Clark Halls; an Assistant Women's basketball coach for three years under Coach Tom Case; the Director of Housing and

Student Activities; the Director of Residence and Campus life; Adjunct Faculty; and even the Title IX Coordinator and Interim Dean of Students. Today, he's the Interim Vice President for Student Services.

In the history of Northwest College, the school has been led by nine different presidents. Throughout the decades, Havig has worked for eight of them.

When asked what some of his fondest memories were, Havig paused before saying "The growth of residential life - I've been here long enough to watch some of my former RA's children become RA's" he chuckled. Many people had an impact on Havig over the years. Former Dean of Students Steve Sims was one of them.

"Steve was very influential, and I'm so thankful for the belief he had in me." Previous Housing Director Ron Peterson and past faculty members Burt Bradley, Rob Koelling and Charlotte Patrick were just a few of many that impacted Havig's tenure at NWC.

"There are so many more," he said. He especially enjoyed working closely with the most recent NWC presidents, Stefani Hicswa and Lisa Watson.

Sadly, Havig has also experienced some of the biggest tragedies at NWC, including the brutal rape and murder of Berry Bryant, car accidents involving students and the fire that destroyed Bridger Hall. Often, in the midst of tragedy, Havig feels it's possible to find a renewed hope in humanity and community. Bryant's story is retold to students each year during residence hall presentations about sexual health and responsibility. Recently, a bench was dedicated in her honor on the Campus Mall, and Havig said that students still go up to Polecat Bench to paint rocks that say "Berry We Miss You." The fire at Bridger Hall displaced over one hundred students at the time, and Havig was tasked with finding a place for them to stay.

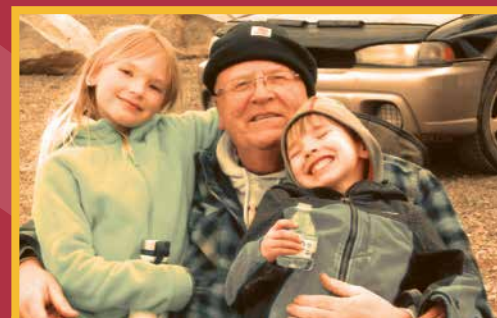
"The community really stepped up; it was amazing," he recalled. "Walmart sent a truck full of much-needed items, and there were so many donations—you really saw the good in people."

Havig is also a tremendous supporter of Northwest College and its students. It's not hard to find him at events such as Paint the Town Red or supporting Trapper Athletic teams. He has also been a generous donor to scholarships, campaigns and programs.

When asked why he continues to give he explains, "I fell in love with NWC, and I have always felt the need to give back." In 2015, Havig's wife Julie passed away after a courageous battle with breast cancer.

"The incredible support for Julie's fundraiser humbled me. I've seen what this college and community does to step up," said Havig.

With retirement on the horizon, there's no doubt Havig has left a lasting impact on generations of students, staff and faculty. His legacy has stamped a mark on Northwest College that can't be erased.

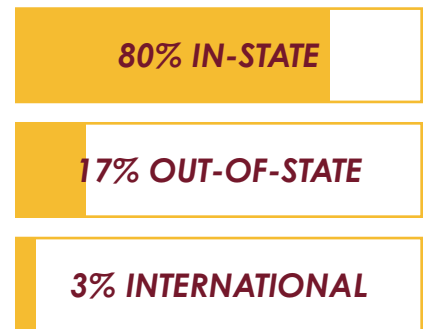
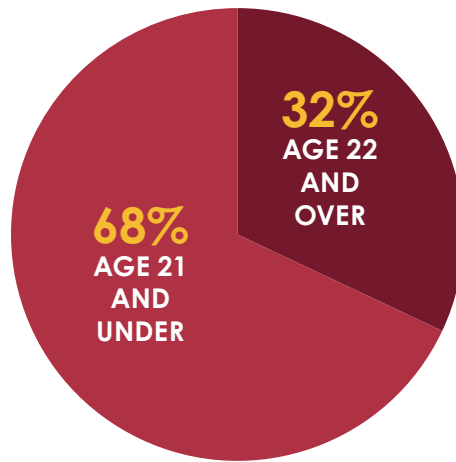
