



Hathaway Scholarship Unmet Need Awards

Calculation of Unmet Need

1. Start with the institution’s general cost of attendance (COA) before adjustments defined as “the sum cost of tuition, mandatory fees, room and board, books and supplies, travel and personal expenses to attend an eligible institution as determined annually by the institution in accordance with W.S. 21-16-1306(b)” in statutes.
2. Subtract from COA, the Estimated Family Contribution on the FAFSA report
3. Subtract Hathaway Merit Award amount
4. Subtract any other grants or scholarships given to the student
5. Subtract \$2,000 Hathaway Scholarship required student commitment
6. The final number is used to determine unmet need

For Performance, Opportunity and Provisional Opportunity Hathaway Scholarships, the amount awarded will be 25% of the annual unmet need above \$2,000 not to exceed \$1,575 per year. Any student receiving the award shall receive a minimum amount of \$105 for each semester of qualification.

Example Calculation Honors Need Award	
Annual Cost of Attendance (Before adjustments)	\$20,000
Estimated Family Contribution	-\$500
Hathaway Merit Scholarship	-\$3,360
Additional Grants and Scholarships Received	-\$1,400
Hathaway Scholarship- Student Commitment	-\$2,000
Unmet need= Total Payout	\$12,740
Total payout per semester	\$6,370

Example Calculation Performance, Opportunity or Provisional Opportunity Need Award	
Annual Cost of Attendance (Before adjustments)	\$20,000
Estimated Family Contribution	-\$500
Hathaway Performance Scholarship	-\$2,520
Additional Grants and Scholarships Received	-\$1,400
Hathaway Scholarship- Student Commitment	-\$2,000
Unmet need	\$13,580
25% of Unmet need	\$3,425
Maximum eligible payment	\$1575
Total payout per semester	\$787.50
