

# VOLUNTEER ILLNESS REPORTING GUIDE

For COVID-19 related illness or exposure, or infection due to another communicable illness, Volunteers are expected to follow NWC COVID-19 processes, the directives of their medical provider, and the Wyoming Department of Health (WDH).

## Requirements –

*Positive Test Result (COVID-19 or other communicable illness)* – Contact your volunteer supervisor to discuss your volunteer service and/or coverage if needed. You may return to volunteer service when you no longer have symptoms of COVID-19 and you have completed your isolation period. Follow your health care provider’s recommendations and/or the Wyoming Department of Health protocols which include the following: If you test positive, stay home for at least 5 days. If after 5 days you are fever free for 24 hours without the use of medication, and your symptoms are improving, or you never had symptoms, you may end isolation after Day 6. You should wear a high-quality mask through Day 10. Day 0 is the first day of symptoms or a positive viral test.

*Exposure (to COVID or other communicable illness)* – Follow your health care provider’s recommendations and/or the Wyoming Department of Health protocols which include the following:

- Wear a high-quality mask for 10 days
- Monitor for symptoms.
