Single parents in Park County, Wyoming, where a single parent leads 24.2% of households, often face unique economic, social, and logistical challenges while providing for their families. This study explores available resources, support systems, and community programs to assist single parents in financial aid, childcare, housing, employment, transportation, and mental health services. By analyzing local government programs, nonprofit organizations, and faith-based initiatives, this research aims to identify gaps in support and opportunities for improvement. Additionally, interviews with single parents and community service providers highlight the most pressing needs and effective solutions. The findings guide community leaders to enhance resource accessibility, ultimately improving the well-being of single-parent households in Park County.
