

The Fisdap exam is offered in an at-home format for the duration of the COVID-19 crisis.

Cost: \$25.25 for 2 attempts (credit, debit, or prepaid card only) to be paid at time of exam.

The Fisdap exam will only be available to take from March 1, 2021 and May 1, 2021 through the EMS Program Office. The exam is required for students who are interested in entering the EMS-Paramedic Program. You must complete this exam before submitting a letter of interest for the Paramedic Program.

Available Dates

March 30 at 1300

April 8 at 0800

April 18 at 1900

The Fisdap Entrance Exam is specific to paramedicine and is a diagnostic tool that assesses students' readiness to enter the Paramedic program.

AREAS TESTED:

- Personality Inventory
- Anatomy and Physiology
- Reading Comprehension
- Math
- EMT (Knowledge, Application and Problem Solving)

• Note: The NWC Paramedic program requires candidates score a 70 or higher on the exam for entrance into the program.

TESTING RULES:

- A photo ID is required to take the Fisdap Exam.
- Textbooks, notebooks, dictionaries, paper and/or children are not allowed in the testing area.
- A white board is preferred for scratch paper.
- Students may retest after 24 hours

TESTING DETAILS:

- Students will contact the EMS Program Coordinator, Whitney Morgan (whitney.morgan@nwc.edu) to arrange for a scheduled time to take the exam. This will be proctored via Zoom. A password from Whitney will be required to take the exam.
